“Trade Chart Patterns Like The Pros” by Suri Duddella

Mark Whiting provides us with a review of Suri Duddella’s “Trade Chart Patterns Like The Pros.”

“Trade Chart Patterns Like The Pros” is an excellent book aimed at technical traders and analysts who rely on chart patterns in their daily trading. The author, Suri Duddella, is a veteran trader and is well known in the trading industry. He is a skilled private trader who is active in the equities, futures and currency markets.

The book focuses on ‘how to’ and ‘what next’ concepts for each of the 65 chart patterns presented. Each pattern is clearly illustrated with entry and exit points along with targets and stops.

What surprised this reviewer was the amount of clarity and detail in the explanation and illustration throughout the book. Along with the large variety of chart patterns, the book also includes over 225 illustrations with specific trade entries/exits and detailed targets/stops. The book includes the most popular chart patterns like ‘Head and Shoulders,’ ‘Cup and Handles’ and ‘Triangles’

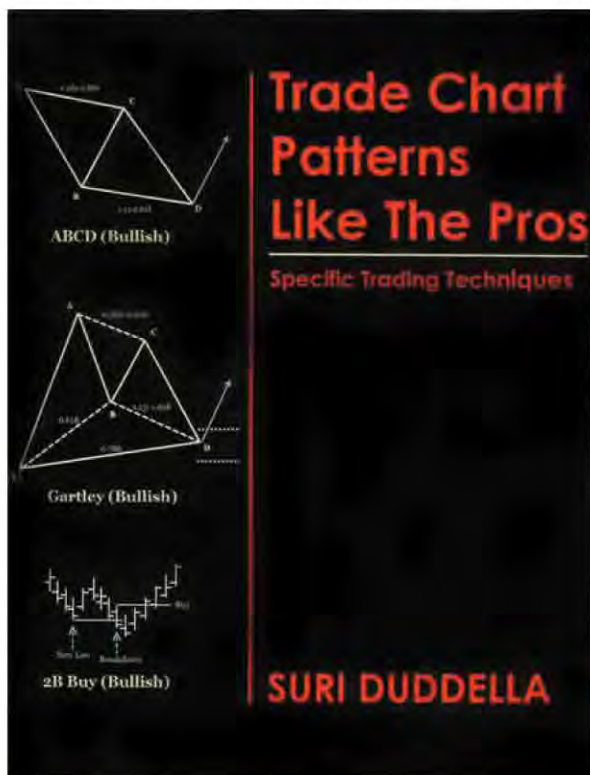
and over 60 other chart patterns. Duddella encourages readers to study and master a few of the chart patterns initially to get comfortable with pattern trading methods.

We especially liked the how each pattern group is organized and arranged in its own category. One chapter on ‘Tops and Bottoms’ has 13 patterns like ‘V-Top,’ ‘Double Top,’ ‘Triple Bottom’ and ‘Triple Top’ and clearly instructs the reader on how to recognize and trade them. Another chapter on ‘Harmonic Patterns’ covers the mystery of ‘Gartley,’ ‘Butterfly,’ ‘Bat’ and ‘Crab’ patterns. We also liked the concepts describing how to trade Opening Range and Fibonacci Zone pivots along with floor trader pivots.

Any trading book that promises advice from the author summons high expectations from its readers... “Trade Chart Patterns Like The Pros” promises specific trading techniques and delivers on those high expectations with clarity.

The book has a Foreword by another veteran trader, Joshua Silverman, who traded with Duddella and compares his trading to the best basketball player’s game. Hedgefolios founder Michael Steinhardt provided a great review and introduced Suri Duddella as one of the best traders to be on his side. Suri Duddella is a master trader. He has researched the subject matter and tested it for years before composing this book. There is little doubt that “Trade Chart Patterns Like The Pros” will soon become the standard reference for chart pattern trading and should be on the desk of seasoned and beginning traders alike.
